



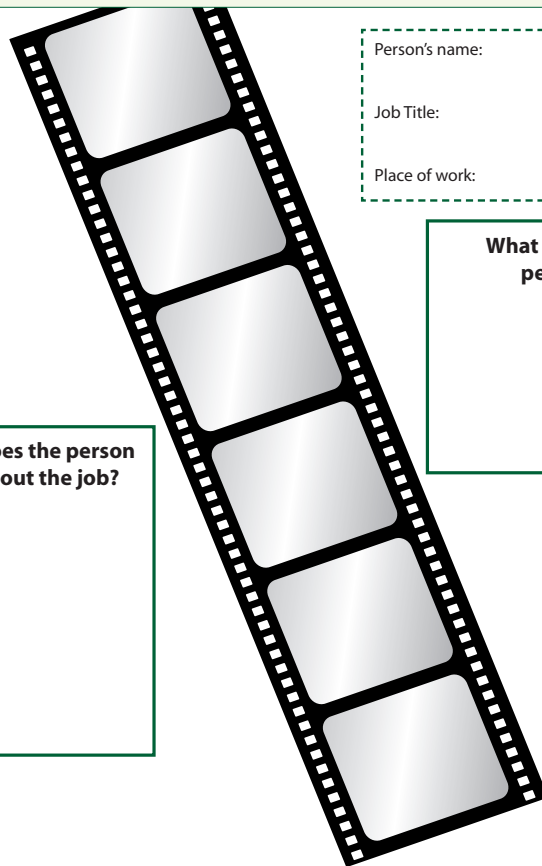
Career Paths

Teacher/Adviser Notes

- The notion that everyone has a career path (the steps along your career so far) is an important one in careers work.
- You might like to fill in the diagram showing a fictitious career path or your own but remember that there are only six spaces! This is intentional since in the videos people don't recount their whole career path but do mention a little of how they got to where they are now.
- In the discussion afterwards focus on why and how people got to where they are now in their careers, including the influences on them.
